2.	Demonstrate the ability to perform otolaryngological procedures in children (e.g., Nasal packing, flexible nasolaryngoscopy, tonsillectomy, adenoidectomy, myringotomy & tube, incision and drainage of neck abscess, basic suturing and knot tying).	Medical Expert
3.	Participate in pre/post-operative management of in-patients who have undergone otolaryngology head & neck surgical procedure(s).	Medical Expert Collaborator
4.	Perform rigid esophagoscopy with or without removal foreign body.	Medical Expert
5.	Perform effective, accurate otoscopy and cerumen removal.	Medical Expert
6.	Interpret tests appropriately, demonstrating an understanding of the pathology underlying the findings on the tests e.g. audiogram, diagnostic imaging	Medical Expert
