Focus

This two-day course will focus on current advances in the management of head and neck tumors. The format will include lectures, panel discussions, and operative techniques. Ample time will be allotted for audience participation through question-and-answer sessions.

- identify the benefits and potential pitfalls of recent advances in head and neck cancer including molecular testing for thyroid nodules, sentinel lymph nodes biopsy in oral cancer, robotic surgery in head and neck malignancy
- apply diagnostic and treatment approaches to head and neck cutaneous malignancy.

The course will be of value to otolaryngologists and head and neck surgeons.
