

# Course Description

This course is directed at residents nearing the end of training, with a goal of preparing for the board exam or practising otolaryngologists seeking a thorough review of contemporary otolaryngology – head and neck surgery. The course will include didactic lectures covering all major areas of otolaryngology – head and neck surgery and finish with a morning of Royal College style mock oral exams. Lectures will focus on the highest yield components of each topic. Last years' course was rated 5/5 overall.
