### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The Annual Otolaryngology Update is a one-day conference geared toward practicing otolaryngologists, allied health professionals, and trainees who wish to enhance their knowledge on various topics spanning the different subspecialties of otolaryngology. A program committee uses divisional input and needs assessment to develop a program that reflects the current key areas of otolaryngology — head & neck surgery. The material will be presented via didactic lectures, followed by audience participation in question and answer sessions along with panel discussions.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- Analyze the current controversies and differing approaches in the management atypical mycobacterium in children
- Discuss evidence-based approaches for managing tracheostomy-related complications
- Review the key surgical techniques and discuss the challenges and solutions in septorhinoplasty

- Examine the latest surgical innovations and biologic therapies in the field of rhinology
- Review the current treatment pathway for well differentiated thyroid cancer by Cancer Care Ontario
- Evaluate and manage patients presenting with Meniere's disease with the most up-to-date Cochrane review evidence
- Plan and execute local flaps in the reconstruction of head/neck skin defects


