COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Annual Otolaryngology Update is a one-day conference geared toward practicing otolaryngologists, allied health professionals, and trainees who wish to enhance their knowledge on various topics spanning the different subspecialties of otolaryngology. A program committee uses divisional input and needs assessment to develop a program that reflects the current key areas of otolaryngology — head & neck surgery. The material will be presented via didactic lectures, followed by audience participation in question and answer sessions along with panel discussions on management of interesting cases.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

After active participation in this update meeting, participants will be able to:

- Discuss the changing landscape of pediatric OSA management
- Identify current approaches to snoring management
- Assess and treat difficult rhinology cases
- Consider the different treatment options for patients with a cough
- Investigate for dysphagia and Interpret of videofluoroscopic swallow
- Implement the most up to date diagnosis and management strategies of tinnitus
- Apply the Incisionless otoplasty technique
- Effectively evaluate and manage patients with extracapsular parotid lesion dissection

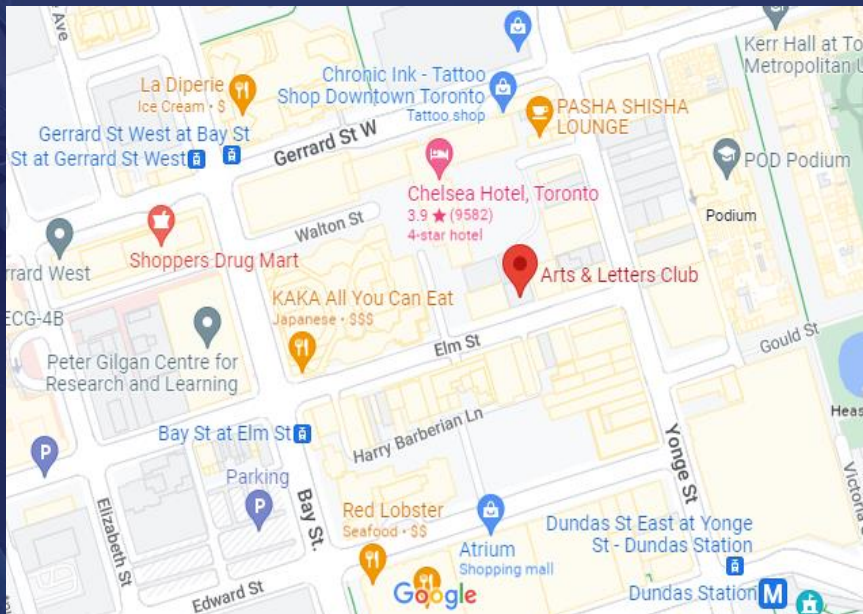
